- When have you ever needed hope that an unfortunate circumstance would get better?
- Where, right now, do you need confidence and hope that God knows and is truly in charge of your situation?
- When have you ever hoped that somehow “everything would make sense in the end”?
- Where is God, right now, teaching you to trust Him more?

## ▶ Level Three “How” questions ◀

- How can the account of Daniel help you to trust God more?
- How can you resist your human shortcomings to doubt God when you are in difficult and trying circumstances?
- How can the circumstances Daniel and his friends went through help you to “stand firm in the faith” like they did?
- Do you think that you will never be put through any “dire straights” because you are a Christian? Why?
- How can the eight doctrinal or spiritual themes in Daniel assist you in your faith?
- How can the six practical reasons why Daniel is important to us help you?
- How might you start living and thinking differently because of this study, so far?
