

▶ Level One “What” questions ◀

- What is the main theme of the book of Daniel?
- What view of the world does the book of Daniel give us?
- What was the cause or reason behind God sending the Babylonian army three times to besiege Jerusalem?
- What should the Jews living in Jerusalem at that time have realized about the sieges?
- Do you think the common, everyday Jew (living in Jerusalem) knew about the sins of their nation that had so angered God? Why/why not?
- If they did know – what could they have done about it?
- What responsibility did the common, everyday Jew have for the sins of their nation?
- Since God had promised Israel abundant blessings (if they remained obedient), what might have been the attitude of a Jew during these times of siege, death and destruction?
- Why couldn't God allow Israel to remain in their sinfulness?
- What is the principle of sowing and reaping? Did this principle apply to Israel? Does it apply to the Christian church, of which you are a part?
- What would you do differently if you knew God's judgment was coming upon the world in six months?

▶ Level Two “When” questions ◀

- When have you ever been warned by God because of your sin?
- Where have you experienced the principle of sowing and reaping?
- Where, right now, are you apprehensive because of this sermon?
- When have you ever made an attempt to reform our society or country?
- When have you ever ignored God, and His warning?

▶ Level Three “How” questions ◀

- In Revelation 3:14 – 22 Jesus gives the Laodicean church a very stern rebuke. How would you respond if you were one of the Laodiceans?
- How has this sermon made you think twice about the USA?
- How has this sermon spurred you on to be really serious about God?
- How does a Christian “sow to please the Spirit?” (Galatians 6:8)
- How can you do this consistently, every day?
- How will you respond to God because of this sermon?
- How can you really take this warning to heart, and make it stick, instead of merely forgetting it?
