

▶ Level One “What” questions ◀

- What would you say is the general setting or overview of the book of Daniel?
- What was common to the last four kings of Judah?
- What characterized each king?
- What similarities or parallels do you see between these four kings and any current ruler, dictator, politician or head of state?
- What choices did each king have? Could they have done good and not evil?
- What if the only possible way for a person today to escape God's coming judgment?
- What is the fall of Jerusalem at the time of Daniel a preview of?
- What are the similarities?
- What eventual consequences from God are there on those who continue in this way?
- What do these similarities cause you to consider about our current society or civilization?
- When were the books of Chronicles written? Why were they written?
- What was God's promise to the exiles? To King David?
- What are the most horrible enslavements of human life?

▶ Level Two “When” questions ◀

- When have you ever observed in your own life a clear-cut choice between following the world and following God and have chosen unreservedly for God?
- When have you ever chosen the world?
- Where, right now, do you have the most decisions whether to choose good (God) or evil (The World)?
- Where, right now, are you most hard pressed to choose between the two?

▶ Level Three “How” questions ◀

- How do you perceive or recognize the world trying to influence you to choose evil?
- How can you keep yourself far away from the wicked characteristics of the four kings we have been talking about?
- How do you think their hearts were corrupted by evil?
- How can you “above all else guard your heart” as in Proverbs 4:23?
- How do you cultivate a “dynamic, living, intimate, relationship” with Jesus, as Zac suggested?
- How can you make this relationship the first priority in your life and not merely an addition to your life?
- (In your opinion) How do many Christians try God's patience?
- How have you tried His patience? How can you, instead – learn what pleases the Lord? (See Galatians 5)
- How will you make the choice to follow God (good) and not the world (evil)?
- How will you, in detail, take this message and put it into practice – every day?
