▶ Level One “What” questions ◀

- What three words does Paul use to describe the variety of God’s action in 1 Corinthians 12:4 – 6?
- For what purpose are spiritual gifts given to the church?
- Who is our example when it comes to serving others?
- What is the first criteria for distinguishing the Holy Spirit’s presence within the use of any spiritual gift?
- What is the second criteria for distinguishing a genuine gift of the Spirit?
- What graphic illustration does Paul use to describe the Church?
- What happens to your body if some part of it doesn’t work, or is damaged?
- What were the Corinthian believers doing to “spoil Christ”?
- What responsibility do we have to other believers in Christ?
- What perspective or viewpoint of believers in Christ should we have?
- What two tendencies can be found in the Body regarding the gifts?
- What is the inevitable outcome of these tendencies?
- Why, for Paul, was the Body of Christ of primary concern, and the individual member secondary? Is this different than many Christian live and believe?

▶ Level Two “When” questions ◀

- When have you ever been built up and encouraged by another Christian?
- When has someone’s thoughtless word or gossip hurt you?
- When have you gossiped or spoken ill of another Christian?
- When have you clearly seen your responsibility to help/encourage/build up another Christian?
- Have you ever seen a believer in need and thought: “That’s someone else’s job”?

▶ Level Three “How” questions ◀

- How can you “undo” the spoiling of Christ that happens?
- How can you view and treat every Christian with equal concern – so there will be no division in our body?
- How are you fulfilling your responsible to and for every member of our body?
- How has God gifted you? How well are you using what He’s given you?
- How does that gifting facilitate the health of our body?
- How do you have to change to enrich the body of Christ & not spoil it?
- How can you realize the role God has chosen and appointed you to fulfill?
- How are you going to start?
- How can your Minichurch help you?
