

### ▶ Level One “What” questions ◀

- What kind of thinking did Zac compare Psalm 23 to?
- What is a “pattern of thinking”?
- Why do you think Zac chose this Psalm for us to model or as an example for us?
- What is your pattern of thinking? What thought(s) occupies most of your time?
- In what way is this different than the pattern of thinking modeled in Psalm 23?
- Read the Psalm verse by verse; what does each verse say about the LORD?
- What does each verse say about you? (Time permitting)
- What effect would you expect to see in your life because of each truth?
- What could happen in you if this Psalm became your pattern of thinking?

### ▶ Level Two “When” questions ◀

- When have you realized that the LORD is your Shepherd?
- When has God ever made you lie down? What was your response?
- When you're lost, confused... where do you turn for guidance?
- Where most does your soul need to be refreshed/restored/revived?
- When have you ever been in a valley of the shadow of death?
- When have you ever feared evil?
- When has your faith in God allowed you to fear no evil?

### ▶ Level Three “How” questions ◀

- How can this Psalm help you to have a Biblical pattern of thinking?
- How can you absorb, understand and make this Psalm change your pattern of thinking?
- How can this Psalm help you to have a proper view of your relationship with the living God?
- How can this Psalm help you to overcome fears and doubts?
- How did Zac recommend we integrate this Psalm into our thinking?
- How well are you doing at this? How can you do better? How have you already benefited from reading this Psalm?
- How can this Mini Church help you to do this?
