- What was your point of view about prophecy before you heard this sermon?
- What has changed in your point of view after hearing this sermon?
- In 1 Corinthians 14:1-5, what can we learn in these verses about prophecy?
- What was the beginning of Christian prophecy?
- Ways words did Zac use to describe the church as a prophetic people?
- What did Zac say about who could deliver prophecy?
- What difference was there between O.T. prophets and N.T. prophets? Were they the same?
- “The N.T. prophet speaks with absolute divine authority.” True/false? Why/why not?
- What scriptures can you use to back up your belief?
- What does this major difference signify about N.T. prophecy? (or) What implications are there for you because of this major difference?
- Since the death of the Apostles, where were Christians to seek for God’s guidance?
- In the local church, what should prophecy always be subject to?
- In 1 Corinthians 14:3, Paul says that a prophet speaks to men for their strengthening, encouragement and comfort. What might this mean for you personally?
- “So, what is New Testament prophecy?” (Define and describe prophecy among your minichurch as Zac suggested) (Here is the Wayne Grudem quote: “Prophecy is speaking merely human words to report something God brings to mind.”)
- What is the purpose of prophecy?
- What guidelines does Paul give for this gifting?
- What criteria or standard should prophecies be evaluated according to?

▶ Level Two “When” questions ◀

- When have you ever heard a prophecy in a Christian setting?
- When has a certain prophecy ever mean a lot to you, or changed the way you live?
- Based upon this sermon, do you think you have ever prophesied?
- Where do you think God can use you, if He gives you this gift?

▶ Level Three “How” questions ◀

- How should you view the gift of prophecy?
- How can you embrace this gift and what it means to the life of your church?
- How can you be a part of helping this gift to build up your church, even if you don’t have the gift of prophecy?
- How do the others “weigh and approve” what is said? (1 Corinthians 14:29)
- How can your mini church be a safe place for you to try out this gift?
- How will you begin?
