

### ▶ Level One “What” questions ◀

- Why do you think that the spiritual gift of tongues has been the most misunderstood, misused and controversial gift in the Christian church?
- What ways did Zac use to describe this gift? (First 2 fill-ins)
- According to 1 Corinthians 14:7-11, what is the sound of the gift of tongues like without any interpretation? Why is the use of uninterrupted tongues prohibited in a church service?
- What were the three purposes for the gift of tongues Zac taught us?
- What other areas did Zac say the gift of tongues may profit an individual?
- What value does the public use of uninterrupted tongues have in a congregation?
- What, then, is necessary for tongues to be used in a public congregation?

### ▶ Level Two “When” questions ◀

- When was the first time you were aware of or understood the gift of tongues?
- When have you ever misunderstood the gift of tongues?
- When (if ever) did you first hear the gift of tongues?
- When (if ever) have you used the gift of tongues? Was your initial experience at all similar to the experience Zac had? Did you doubt the gift?
- When have you ever wanted the gift of tongues?

### ▶ Level Three “How” questions ◀

- Since the private use of the gift of tongues is for one's personal profit; how should you view the use of this gift?
- How should a Christian utilize this gift in the best way possible?
- How can this gift be misused?
- How should a Christian with the gift of tongues regard a Christian without this gift?
- How should a Christian without the gift of tongues regard a Christian with this gift?
- How can you at all costs avoid any division in the Body of Christ over this gift?
- How can the gift of tongues help a Christian grow and mature?
- How should you regard the use of uninterrupted tongues in a public church service?
- How often or to what extent should a Christian with this gift use it?
- How can you use this gift for the common good?
