5. Why is accurate doctrine important?
6. In 1 John 2:22, what is the meaning of how the “antichrists” deny the Father and the Son?

▶ Level Two “When” questions ◀

7. (Share about) When have you ever been challenged with a deviant teaching or idea that was contrary to what you have been taught?
8. (Share about) When have you ever searched the Scriptures diligently to determine the validity of someone's statement about the Christian faith?
9. (Share about) Where do you feel you need to be stronger in regards to your faith?

▶ Level Three “How” questions ◀

10. How does a Christian's faith become stronger?
11. How can you take an active role in doing this? (Rather than passive.)
12. How can you be on guard against aberrant or deviant teaching about Jesus?
13. See 1 John 4. How do you “test the spirits”?
14. How can you be (or become) ready for anything that threatens our faith?
15. Zac said: “Our task is to be prepared for Christ's return and tell others the good news so they too will be prepared.” How can you prepare yourself for Christ's return? How can you tell others about the good news?
16. How will you personally put what this sermon has taught you into practice?
