- Why did he ask them to tell him not only the interpretation, but also the dream itself?
- What is the first thing Daniel does when he is made aware of the situation?
- What two aspects of God does Daniel highlight in his prayer in vss. 20-23?
- Why do you think Daniel selects these two aspects of God?
- What is the content of Nebuchadnezzar's dream?
- What two significant truths do we learn from the dream?
- What does the Rock do, and what does this signify?

- Where or to whom do you look for help when you are disturbed?
- When trials, testing and troubles come our way, who (or what) do we usually believe is the origin of them?
- When have you found it most difficult to keep your composure and solid confidence in God?

- How does the story of Daniel help you to trust in the Lord?
- How do you typically respond to the Lord when you encounter trials? (Complain?)
- How does it reflect upon our Lord when we whine, complain, moan, bellyache and grumble?
- How can we respond to trials in a way that would bring glory and honor to God?
- How can James (in James 1) tell us to “Consider it pure joy, my brothers, whenever you face trials of many kinds”? How is this possible? (Or is it?)
- How can the understanding that the God of Daniel is *your* God help you to face any trial?
- How does responding in obedient faith to God's revealed will help you to grow in faith?
- How can you, personally, in detail, grow in your faith?
- How will you choose to put this sermon into practice?
