

▶ Level One “What” questions ◀

- What was difficult about living in Babylon for Daniel and his three friends?
- Why is it very difficult to cooperate with someone and yet still not compromise?
- What were some of the “new things” they were indoctrinated with in Babylon?
- What did Daniel choose to “draw the line” at in verse eight?
- What does it mean to you to remain an “inner” stranger to the life and culture in which you are immersed?
- What stresses and trials might living like this have caused Daniel and his three friends?
- What was the probable reason why Daniel chose the area of diet as the moral/theological line over which he refuses to step?
- Who was orchestrating all the circumstances and events in the lives of these three?
- What certainty did Daniel and his three friends have that this circumstance would go their way?
- What point does chapter one of Daniel drive home?

▶ Level Two “When” questions ◀

- When have you ever been put into a difficult choice; between a boss and the Lord?
- When have you chosen God? The boss? What happened?
- Where, right now, do you most feel the stress to comply with the “powers that be”, and not obey the Lord?
- When you choose to obey the Lord, where have you put your confidence? Is it always easy to keep your confidence in the Lord in times like these?

▶ Level Three “How” questions ◀

- Zac said that we must be able to articulate these three doctrines below. Take some time to “role play” and see how well (or poorly) you can do:
- How do you witness to:
 - (a) The nature of God? (b) The gospel. (c) The meaning of life on earth?
- How important is it that we as Christians can articulate and communicate these points?
- On the back of the notes are other questions Zac suggested we think through:
 - (1) How often has the culture around enticed me to commit some sin?
 - (2) How often have the luxuries of the world tempted me to disobey God?
 - (3) How often have I allowed my desire for position, power, or fame to consume me?
 - (4) How often have I put achieving my personal ambition before serving God?
 - (5) Where do I draw the line?
- How do you (in a particular situation) draw the line?
